Prayer Points

Our Church Family

- Please pray for Steve, Martin and Matt as they preach and lead services in the new year. Pray that through the early ministry of Jesus they and we might see what it means that Jesus is the Spirit-anointed saviour, messiah and lord and that we all might hear John's call to live repentant lives.
- Pray for the many people who came to our Christmas services and events: friends, family members, colleagues, and people from Cowan Lodge, toddler group and Community Coffee. Give thanks that the gospel was proclaimed and pray that the Lord will be at work bringing the repentance and faith that only he can bring about.
- Pray for our pastor, elders and deacon that they might enter this new year with joy in their hearts and ready to serve our Lord afresh as he has called and equipped them.
- Pray for all of us in our church family as we return to 'normal life' after the Christmas season. Pray for the deep joy in the Lord that so many in Luke 1-2 felt and displayed in these short, cold, dark January days. Pray particularly for those struggling with poor physical or mental health, those not able to get along to church regularly, the bereaved, and those struggling with work, family relationships and/or friendships. Pray that we all might rejoice in the peace with him that God has brought us through Christ in and despite our earthly circumstances.
- Pray for our mission partners as they return to service after (hopefully!) a period of rest. Pray for Steve and Rachel Ball as they restart their regular groups and for Rachel as she leads an online seminar on teaching children effectively. Pray for Luke and Claudette Baldwin as they support their church, disciple believers, look for opportunities with unbelievers and prayerfully explore future family decisions. Our Nation

Eritrea—Give thanks that Christians were among those released from prison last month. Pray for healing from their ordeal, smooth reunions with family and reintegration into society. Pray for the wellbeing and release of believers still held unfairly, and for just and fair rule by the authorities.
